Numeracy

- Make a schedule for the day

- Look at/ listen to the weather forecast.

- Can you choose a story to enjoy? Can you answer some questions (who, what, where) about the text? Think of the feelings of the character. What may happen next? Did you like the text? (Use your voice, device, Signalong or pointing/visuals to answer.)
